WARNING

This Park is unsupervised and use of it may result in serious injury. User assumes all risks inherent in the use of this facility. The use of proper safety equipment is strongly recommended for all skaters. Failure to wear safety equipment exposes skaters to greater risk of injury. HELMET, ELBOW PADS, KNEE PADS, and WRIST GUARDS are recommended. The Town of Waterford is not responsible for the loss or damage to personal property or for personal injury.

HOURS OF OPERATION

- The Park is OPEN during daylight hours, seven (7) days a week.
- The Park is CLOSED when the gates are locked and/or during inclement weather.
- Use of the Park when the gate is locked constitutes trespassing and trespassers will be charged accordingly.

GENERAL SKATEBOARD PARK RULES

- The park is for SKATEBOARDING ONLY. BIKES ARE PROHIBITED.
- Items such as benches, tables, homemade ramps and other objects shall not be used within the fenced in area, or placed on the skating surface.
- Skating is prohibited on the curbs, driveway, sidewalks, and stairs surrounding the Skate Park.
- Spectators and non-skaters should remain off the skating surface.
- Alcohol, tobacco and drugs are prohibited.
- All trash must be placed within the trash receptacles provided. No glass containers should be brought into the Park area. Failure to keep the area clean will result in the Park being locked.
- Children age 10 and younger should be supervised by a parent.

COURTESY

- Skate with the flow of skaters. Proceed when ramps and obstacles are clear of other skaters.
- Profanity, recklessness, and rowdy behavior are prohibited.

- Give all skaters a chance to skate.
